

Security Procedure Check-In/Check-Out Policy

We care about the safety of our children! A check-in/check-out policy has been implemented to ensure the safety of our children. Children in the nursery, preschool, or kindergarten will receive a numbered sticker and the parent will receive an identical numbered sticker. Children will be released to their parents at the conclusion of class upon presentation of the matching sticker by the parent. Children in grades one through five must also be signed into class by a parent. At that time the parent and child will receive matching numbered wrist bands. Children will be released to their parents at the conclusion of class upon presentation of the matching wristband. Your cooperation with our policy is appreciated!

Welcome to CROSS Training!

What is CROSS training?? Formerly known as Sunday School, CROSS training is our Sunday morning programs for children nursery through high school.

The nursery, preschool, and kindergarten curriculum utilizes an exciting multimedia program that teaches about faith, service, evangelism, fellowship, worship; the list goes on and on. The lessons and accompanying video series teach children to live their lives so that it is pleasing to God. Each series lasts approximately 8 weeks.

Children in grades 1-5 participate in a rotation worship model curriculum. Each rotation, or theme, lasts approximately 4 weeks. During the rotation children travel to different workshops each week where they will participate in hands-on, multi-sensory, fun-filled activities.

Our workshops are:

Thou Art (Art), Cobblestone Café (Cooking), Matters of Faith (Science), Reel to Real (Movie), Temple Times (Games), and Tent Tales (Drama).

Our teachers are called 'coaches'.

As with sports organizations and school PTA, the children's Sunday morning programs can not operate without parent volunteers. Coaches are needed for each rotation; coaching signups begin approximately two weeks prior to the new rotation.

Parents of children nursery to fifth grade are expected to volunteer to teach. We can't teach your children without you!

New and exciting things are happening in CROSS Training. Some may be messy!! Please dress accordingly! Won't you join us?

Middle and High School:

Middle and High School classes are offered during 9:00 a.m. worship hour. Middle school students are 6th-8th grade. Parents of middle students are expected to sign up for a week to provide donuts for the class on a rotating basis. High School students are 9th-12th grade. Parents of high school students are expected to sign up to volunteer for a week to help in the class and provide donuts on a rotating basis.

Confirmation class is offered during the school year at the 9:00 worship hour for students in 8th grade.

Vacation Bible School

Vacation Bible School is offered during the third week of July. Registration typically begins the first Sunday in June. Registration forms are available online during the registration period.

Child Protection Policy Training:

Anyone who volunteers in Children/Youth ministry must attend Child Protection Policy Training.

You can still volunteer without the training; however, until you have attended a training session, you will be teamed with someone who has completed the training.

Training sessions are held twice a year, during the summer prior to Vacation Bible School and during the school year, preferably Fall and Winter time frame.

Notes of Interest:

A monthly newsletter is produced filled with information parents need.

Registration forms for nursery through high school will be available online. Every child must have a registration form on file.
