# Ministry in Action

- **1** 2021 SUPER BOWL OF CARING: Many in our community are struggling with food insecurities. There is an enormous need to help put food on our brothers and sisters' tables. As a Matthew 25 church we are called to reach out to those in need. In years past we have done this by participating in the Souper Bowl of Caring.
  - This year's event will be held on February 6<sup>th</sup> (with February 13<sup>th</sup> as a rain date) from 10:00 AM 12:45 PM in the church parking lot. We will collect non-perishable food and other general items for the ACTS Hunger Prevention Center. If possible, place your donations in your car's trunk to enable a contactless drop off.
  - Please ensure you are wearing a mask and adhere to the six feet social distancing protocol.

- Examples of items needed are: canned and dried vegetables, fruit and meats, breakfast items, peanut butter and jelly, macaroni and cheese, whole-grain pasta, canned tomato sauce, canned soup, coffee, cooking oil, Pull-Ups and diapers size 5/6, soap, toothpaste, deodorant, shampoo, laundry detergent, feminine hygiene products, etc.
- Please check all expiration dates and ensure food items have not expired.
- Your generosity in helping to provide healthy non-perishable food and other needed items to those in need is an expression of God's love for all. Thank you for helping us tackle hunger in Prince William County!
- ASH WEDNESDAY: On Ash Wednesday, February 17<sup>th</sup>, there will be a worship service at 7:00 PM with Communion and Imposition of Ashes. ### DEACONS: THE MINISTRY OF COMPASSION AND SERVICE

The ministry of deacon as set forth in Scripture is one of compassion, witness, and service, sharing in the redeeming love of Jesus Christ for the poor, the hungry, the sick, the lost, the friendless, the oppressed, those burdened by unjust policies or structures, or anyone in distress. Persons of spiritual character, honest repute, exemplary lives, brotherly and sisterly love, sincere compassion, and sound judgment should be chosen for this ministry.<sup>1</sup>

### RULING ELDERS: THE MINISTRY OF DISCERNMENT AND GOVERNANCE

As there were in Old Testament times elders for the government of the people, so the New Testament church provided persons with particular gifts to share in discernment of God's Spirit and governance of God's people. Accordingly, congregations should elect persons of wisdom and maturity of faith, having demonstrated skills in leadership and being compassionate in spirit. Ruling elders are so named not because they "lord it over" the congregation (Matt. 20:25), but because they are chosen by the congregation to discern and measure its fidelity to the Word of God, and to strengthen and nurture its faith and life. Ruling elders, together with teaching elders, exercise leadership, government, spiritual discernment, and discipline and have responsibilities for the life of a congregation as well as the whole church, including ecumenical relationships. When elected by the congregation, they shall serve faithfully as members of the session. When elected as commissioners to higher councils, ruling elders participate and vote with the same authority as teaching elders, and they are eligible for any office.<sup>2</sup>
