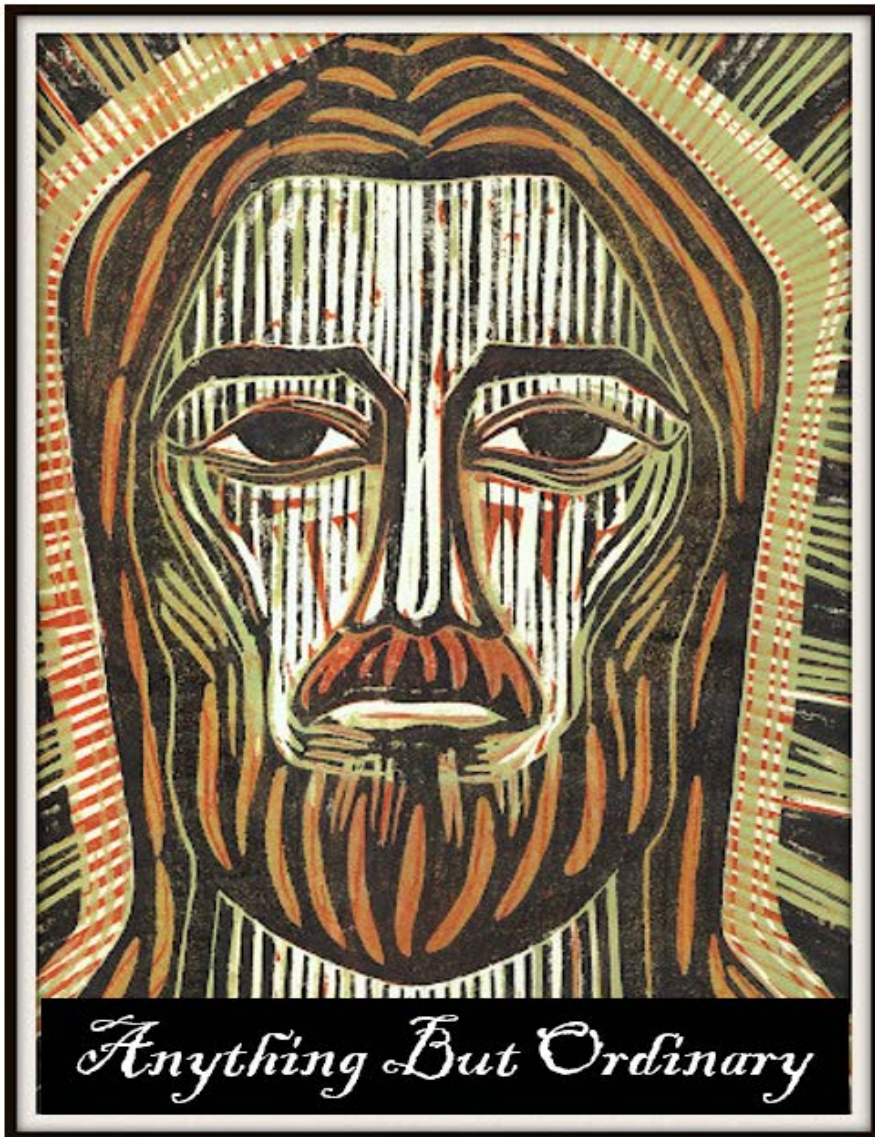

## *Ministry in Action*

- ✝ **LENTEN STUDY:** On Sundays, February 14<sup>th</sup> - March 21<sup>st</sup> from 8:30 - 9:30 AM on Zoom, join us for FORGIVENESS: A Lenten Study. This is a Lenten study by Marjorie Thompson, a Presbyterian pastor. She wished to explore the way we practice our approach to our Christian duty. Everyone has experienced or is experiencing forgiveness in some form. Is forgiving the best path to healing for the injured? Are there emotional barriers involved with forgiveness? With lively discussion, and much scripture throughout our 6-week journey, we will create a livable and meaningful definition of forgiveness. While Forgiveness is a Christ taught virtue, we were never given instructions on application!
- \* **2021 SUPER BOWL OF CARING:** Many in our community are struggling with food insecurities. There is an enormous need to help put food on our brothers and sisters' tables. As a Matthew 25 church we are called to reach out to those in need. In years past we have done this by participating in the Souper Bowl of Caring.
  - This year's event will be held on **February 6<sup>th</sup>** (with February 13<sup>th</sup> as a rain date) from **10:00 AM - 12:45 PM** in the church parking lot. We will collect non-perishable food and other general items for the ACTS Hunger Prevention Center. If possible, place your donations in your car's trunk to enable a contactless drop off.
  - *Please ensure you are wearing a mask and adhere to the six feet social distancing protocol.*
  - **Examples of items needed are:** canned and dried vegetables, fruit and meats, breakfast items, peanut butter and jelly, macaroni and cheese, whole-grain pasta, canned tomato sauce, canned soup, coffee, cooking oil, Pull-Ups and diapers size 5/6, soap, toothpaste, deodorant, shampoo, laundry detergent, feminine hygiene products, etc.
  - **Please check all expiration dates and ensure food items have not expired.**
  - Your generosity in helping to provide healthy non-perishable food and other needed items to those in need is an expression of God's love for all. Thank you for helping us tackle hunger in Prince William County!

- \* **ASH WEDNESDAY:** On Ash Wednesday, February 17<sup>th</sup>, there will be a worship service at 7:00 PM with Communion and Imposition of Ashes. We are asking participants to gather their own elements of bread and cup for communion. We also ask you to gather your own ashes (from a fire pit, fireplace, etc.) for the Imposition of Ashes. If you cannot gather ashes, you can substitute oil for the ashes (olive oil for example). A shorter Lenten scripture and prayer service will be available online each Wednesday at 7:00 PM through March 24<sup>th</sup>. On Thursday, April 1<sup>st</sup>, we will celebrate Maundy Thursday online at 7:00 PM with virtual communion. Chancel Choir will meet at 7:30 PM immediately following each Wednesday prayer service. Wednesday Night Bible Study will resume after Easter on Wednesday, April 14<sup>th</sup>.
