

2020 SUPER BOWL OF CARING: Many in our community are struggling with food insecurities. There is an enormous need to help put food on our brothers and sisters' tables. As a Matthew 25 church we are called to reach out to those in need. In years past we have done this by participating in the Souper Bowl of Caring.

This year's event will be held on February 12th (with February 19th as a rain date) from 10:00 AM - 12:45 PM in the church parking lot. We will collect non-perishable food and other general items for the ACTS Hunger Prevention Center. If possible, place your donations in your car's trunk to enable a contactless drop off.

Please ensure you are wearing a mask and adhere to the six feet social distancing protocol.

Examples of items needed are: canned and dried vegetables, fruit and meats, breakfast items (cold cereal, oatmeal, grits, etc.),12 oz. peanut butter and jelly, macaroni and cheese, wholegrain pasta, canned tomato sauce, canned soup, canned vegetables, ground and instant coffee, cooking oil, diapers size 6, children's Pull-ups, soap, toothpaste, deodorant, shampoo, laundry detergent, dish soap, toilet paper, feminine hygiene products, pet food, etc.

Please check all expiration dates and ensure food items have not expired.

Your generosity in helping to provide healthy non-perishable food and other needed items to those in need is an expression of God's love for all. Thank you for helping us tackle hunger in Prince William County.

- * MISSION OPPORTUNITY: Military bases are closing down their Afghan refugee intake, and families are beginning the process of re-settlement in the USA. They all have "Special Immigrant Visas," green cards, some cash—but imagine yourself in their situation.
 - How can we help? Do you, or someone you know, have a living space, apartment, or home that could be rented for the short or long-term? Would you be willing to spend some time for a one-time project, or as a friend, one-on-one and for the long-term?
 - Our Mission Team has agreed to support the work of the Refugee Ministry Team at Greenwich Presbyterian Church, in the Manassas area, which has supported Afghan families for over three years. They match car, furniture, and household goods donations with the families that need them. They have occasional one-time service opportunities. They provide training for anyone who is interested in a long-term commitment as a contact person with a family. Two of our members have already been in a very rewarding relationship with a family who have settled in Dumfries. Hamilton explores how Jews and Christians have understood the Ten Commandments over the millennia and how the latest research in science and psychology illuminates these commandments, rightly understood as a way of ordering one's life beautifully in the present day.
